This successful project encouraged local communities to get involved and assist tradespeople in transforming their houses and community buildings.

McMahon Services were eager to get involved in the project, aimed at giving back to Indigenous communities. Our team worked closely with the local Indigenous people, and remained respectful of the each community's different cultural sensitivities.
