

Compact Rotary Drill - Micro Piling

The Ripamonti Birdie is a compact rotary drill, ideal for foundation work, civil engineering and drilling where a smaller, easily transportable drill is desired. The Birdie has stood up to tough and remote drilling conditions around the world, and excels at anchoring, micropiles, shallow water wells, restoration jobs as well as geotechnical and environmental investigations.

The Birdie is suitable for drilling with 3 inch and 4 inch DTH hammers and hydraulic light drifters, and can be disassemble into a few light and compact pieces, making this unit very versatile and easy to transport.

Key Features include:

- Light and compact
- Capable of installing up to 100 piles per day
- Drill mast is detachable from the rig, allowing for use on scaffolds
- Truck mounted for rough terrain

- Extendable track base (760 1160 mm wide) enabling access to tight areas
- Radio remote control panel

- Clamping device and breaking up for up to 150mm diameter piles
